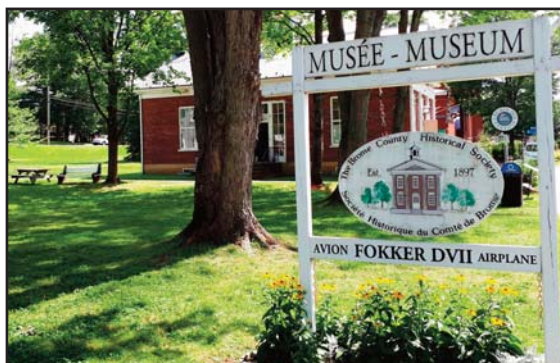

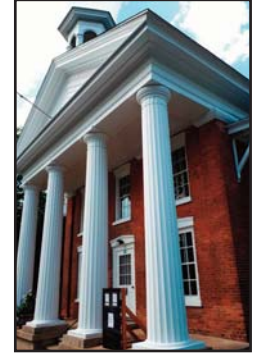

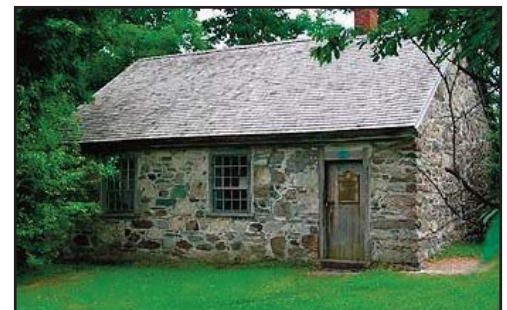

Historic Lakeview Inn, Knowlton

Built in 1874, the Lakeview catered in its early years to stagecoach travelers. With the arrival of the railroad, the inn grew in popularity. In its heyday, the well-to-do from across Canada stayed here. Guests included Prime Ministers Sir Wilfrid Laurier, Sir Robert Borden and many others.

Visitors were greeted at the train station, and conveyed to the hotel in horse-drawn carriages. During the summer, there was croquet, tennis and boat rides on Brome Lake. On Saturday evenings, the inn was alive with the music of an orchestra.

Painstakingly restored in recent years, the Lakeview retains its authentic Victorian charm. The inn is known for the quality of its hospitality and customer service.
